THE MINNEHAHA COUNTY COMMISSION CONVENED AT 9:00 A.M. May 27, 2014 pursuant to adjournment on May 20, 2014. Commissioners present were: Barth, Beninga, Heiberger, Kelly, and Pekas. Also present were Robert Litz, Auditor, and Kersten Kappmeyer, Chief Civil Deputy State's Attorney.

Chairman Heiberger called the meeting to order.

MOTION by Barth, seconded by Pekas, to approve the agenda. 5 ayes.

MOTION by Pekas, seconded by Barth, to approve the May 20, 2014 Commission Minutes with a correction to Resolution MC14-27 as follows. 5 ayes.

RESOLUTION MC14-27

WHEREAS, a County Aid Lien in the amount of \$4,010.93 purports to exist in favor of Minnehaha County and against DPNO 56895 as Lienee, and a County Aid Lien in the amount of \$1,027.43 purports to exist in favor of Minnehaha County and against DPNO 62884, and

WHEREAS, said lienee has filed an application with the County Auditor stating such facts as provided for by Law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that after due consideration of the circumstances the Board of County Commissioners finds it advisable and proper to authorize the Chairman of the County Board and the County Auditor to execute the following:

NOTICES

Mike Milstead, Sheriff, reported that a review committee has recommended the use of conducted electrical weapons for law enforcement as a less lethal option. Sheriff Milstead stated that grants are available for funding the purchase of the weapons. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Auditor to publish notice to bidders for the purchase of conducted electrical weapons for the Sheriff's Department. 5 ayes.

Michelle Boyd, Chief Deputy Sheriff, reported that the City of Sioux Falls and Minnehaha County will receive \$70,599 through the 2014 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant. Under a joint spending plan proposal the City of Sioux Falls will receive \$45,889 and the County will receive \$24,710. The County funds are proposed to be used for training, equipment, ammunition, and office furniture. Ms. Boyd requested authorization to post notice of a public hearing on June 10, 2014, to consider the spending plan. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Pekas to authorize the Auditor to post Notice of Hearing on June 10, 2014 to consider the 2014 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Joint Spending Plan. 5 ayes.

PLANNING & ZONING NOTICES

Scott Anderson, Planning & Zoning Director, requested authorization for the Auditor to publish a notice of hearing for text amendments to the 2002 Revised Joint Zoning Ordinance for Minnehaha County and the City of Sioux Falls. The amendments to be considered are for revisions regarding solar energy conversion systems. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Beninga, to authorize the Auditor to publish a notice of hearing to consider text amendments to the 2002 Revised Joint Zoning Ordinance for Minnehaha County and the City of Sioux Falls on June 24, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. at a Joint Meeting of the Minnehaha County Commission and the Sioux Falls City Council. 5 ayes.

LIEN COMPROMISE

Commissioner Pekas gave a briefing on a request for compromise of lien for DPNO 58675 in the amount of \$1,701.10. The Commission considered this request on May 20, 2014, with four Commissioners present. The motion made for compromising DPNO 58675 resulted in a split vote that deferred further consideration until a full Commission was present. The lien is in the name of the applicant and his ex-wife, and is for attorney services provided for their minor children. The applicant is in the process of refinancing his home and the title company identified the lien. He is asking for a compromise and release of the lien in full as it applies to himself and his property upon payment of \$638, leaving the balance of the lien only in the name of his ex-wife. The applicant made a similar request in February, 2013, during a previous attempt to refinance his home. At that time the Commission approved a full compromise as it applied to the applicant and his property upon payment of \$638.00. The refinancing was not successful and the applicant has made no payment on the lien. The full amount of the lien was reinstated after one year from the approval date of the compromise. MOTION by Pekas, seconded by Barth, to deny the request for compromise of lien for DPNO 58675. Commissioner Pekas stated that the applicant made no payments on the previous lien compromise and doesn't believe that the offer should be extended for a

5/27/2014 second time. Vote on motion, 5 ayes.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Ron Weber, 46631 Prairie Drive, Sioux Falls, and David Newell, 46642 Prairie Drive, Sioux Falls, spoke on issues of concern regarding their neighbor.

HEARING

Scott Anderson, Planning & Zoning Director, was present for the Public Hearing and gave the second reading of Ordinance MC 16-134-14 to amend the 1990 Revised Zoning Ordinance. The ordinance is to rezone approximately .29 acres from A-1 Agriculture District to C Commercial District at the corner of SD Highway 115 and County Highway 122 for future development. The Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of re-zoning request #14-04 at their April 28th meeting. The applicant is requesting the re-zoning with the intent to develop a small repair shop on the property. No one spoke for or against the re-zoning request. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Pekas, to approve Ordinance MC16-134-14. 5 ayes. The entire ordinance is on file in the Auditor's Office.

AGREEMENTS

Jason Reaves, Project Engineer, gave a briefing on land acquisition for replacement of Structures 50-142-120 and 50-143-120. Mr. Reaves stated that it is desired to have 50' of right-of-way (each side of the section line) on all county highways. In addition, it is standard to acquire right-of-way in the immediate location of a structure reconstruction or renovation on county highways to allow county crews full access to the structure for maintenance. The Highway Department requested the following three land purchases: #1) Monte Oyen in the amount of \$1.00 for 0.08 acres for structure right-of-way; #2) Lorraine Pearson in the amount of \$1.00 for 0.08 acres of road right-of-way; #2) Lorraine Pearson in the amount of \$1.00 for 0.39 acres of road right-of-way. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Pekas, to authorize the Chairman to sign the right-of-way agreements for all three three land purchases. Chairman Heiberger and Commissioner Beninga stated that they feel purchasing 0.39 acres of road right-of-way for \$3,238.00 would set a precedent for future right-of-way acquisitions. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Barth, to amend the original motion by eliminating purchase #3, the purchase of 0.39 acres for \$3,238.00. 5 ayes. VOTE on original motion as amended, 5 ayes.

NEW BUSINESS

Ken McFarland, Commission Administrative Officer, stated that there will be a commission meeting next week on Primary Election Day, June 3, 2014, but it will be kept very short.

OLD BUSINESS

Bob Litz, Auditor, stated that for the Primary Election on June 3, 2014, we will be using precincts as opposed to voting centers. Mr. Litz further stated that the City of Sioux Falls and Sioux Falls School Districts, have chosen to use voting centers for their elections; however for Primary and General Elections the county will continue to use precincts at this time.

MOTION by Pekas, seconded by Barth, to go into executive session for personnel and contract negotiations. 5 ayes.

The Commission adjourned until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 3, 2014.
