LIEN COMPROMISE

Commissioner Barth gave a briefing on a petition for compromise of lien for DPNO 53827 in the amount of \$5,588.42. The petition was submitted by Paul W. Tschetter, Boyce Law Firm, LLP, who has been retained by Mr. Ron Bosch, in coordination with the City of Sioux Falls and Affordable Housing Solutions, to assist in quieting title to the real property located at 1420 E. 3rd Street, Sioux Falls, SD. Mr. Bosch entered into a contract for deed for the sale of the property with the individuals listed on the lien. The liens became attached to the property as a result of the filing for the contract for deed. The individuals on the lien have been unable to make payments on the contract for deed and are attempting to quit claim the property back to Mr. Bosch. The petitioner is requesting a compromise and release of the lien against the real property owned by Mr. Bosch. Kersten Kappmeyer, Chief Civil Deputy State's Attorney, encouraged the Commission to approve the lien compromise. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Beninga, to approve Resolution MC15-56. 4 ayes.

The petitioner is asking for a compromise and release of the lien against himself, upon payment of \$236.25 and for the balance of the lien to be solely against his ex-wife. Commissioner Barth stated that in the past liens against family members for IVC's have been released without payment, and he feels this is a wrong burden to go against the parents. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Beninga, to compromise and release the lien in full with no payment. Commissioner Beninga stated that the applicant did

not provide the financial information requested on the application. Commissioner Bender stated parents bear a lot of burdens for their children that other people would not, and that she would be in favor of the petitioners request to pay half of the lien amount and leave the balance only in the name of his ex-wife. Commissioner Heiberger agreed with Commissioner Bender. Vote on motion, 1 aye. Bender, Beninga, and Heiberger voted nay. Motion fails. MOTION by Bender, seconded by Beninga to approve Resolution MC15-57. 3 ayes. Barth voted nay. Motion carries.

Commissioner Barth gave a briefing on a request for a compromise of lien for DPNO 9945 in the amount of \$24,916.16. The applicants are a married couple and the lien is for significant medical expenses the wife incurred. The full cost of the medical bills exceeded \$69,000 and the catastrophic pool that insures the county against large medical claims was utilized in this case. Both the husband and wife are employed and report a total 2014 income of \$53,021.80. They claim resources of less than \$2,000 and own 2 vehicles. Their debts include \$14,500 to Empire Federal Credit Union, \$5,900 to Care Credit, \$3,400 to Community Health and \$15,000 to collection agencies. They have secured a VA loan and identified a home to purchase contingent on the resolution of the lien. Their current rent payment is \$750 per month, and the home mortgage payment, taxes, and all other costs would be approximately \$550 per month. The husband spoke on events beginning in 1989 with the murder of their daughter that contributed to their current situation. Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, explained the utilization of the catastrophic insurance. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Beninga to approve Resolution MC15-58. 4 ayes.

BUDGET SUPPLEMENT

Kari Benz, Human Services Assistant Director, requested a supplement of \$33,213 from the Emergency Food & Shelter Program (EFSP) Fund to the EFSP Budget representing the 2015 EFSP Allocation. Ms. Benz reported that Minnehaha County Human Services provides case management for families at the Bishop Dudley Hospitality House. Minnehaha County has experienced a reduction of approximately 50% in costs for providing hotel rooms since the opening of the Bishop Dudley Hospitality House. The 2015 EFSP Allocation will be forwarded to the Bishop Dudley Hospitality House. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Beninga to supplement \$33,213 from the Emergency Food & Shelter Program Fund to the Emergency Food & Shelter Program Budget, ASN 21137. 4 ayes.

DISUCUSSION

Robert Wilson, Assistant Commission Administrative Officer, reported on the status of the 2015 Proposed Resolutions and Policy Statements for the 101st Annual Convention of the South Dakota Association of County Commissioners. Commissioners discussed the resolutions.

LIAISON REPORTS

Commissioner Barth reported the Minnehaha County Planning & Zoning Department will represent Minnehaha County at the water conference organized by Mayor Huether on Thursday, September 10, 2015.

Commissioner Barth commented that the budgets presented at the Joint City of Sioux Falls/Minnehaha County budget hearing meeting were previously presented to both governments. Mr. Barth stated he feels having a second presentation may not be the best use of time, and the budgets could be approved without the second presentation.

Commissioner Beninga reported on attending the South East Council of Government Board of Director's Meeting. They approved their 2016 budget with a slight increase. Mr. Beninga reported that normally they sell 3 to 5 Governor's houses each year, and this year they have orders for 20 houses. They also held a discussion on the relocation of about 60 homes around Avera.

NEW BUSINESS

Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, reminded the Commission that the Southeast District Meeting is tomorrow, Wednesday, September 9th in Yankton, and that due to the South Dakota Association of County Commissioners annual convention, there will not be a commission meeting on September 15th.

OLD BUSINESS

Robert Wilson, Assistant Commission Administrative Officer, gave an update on the rule making process for the definition of "waters of the U.S." within the Clean Water Act. Mr. Wilson reported there has been an injunction by a Federal Judge in North Dakota to halt the implementation of the new rules from going into effect at this time.

Commissioner Heiberger reported that she has been nominated to be on the Judicial and Safety Committee of the National Association of Counties.

MOTION by Barth, seconded by Bender, to adjourn into executive session for personnel. 4 ayes.

The Commission adjourned until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday September 22, 2015.
