Special Personnel Action

LIEN COMPROMISE

The applicant is in the process of purchasing a home and needs to have the lien resolved prior to closing on March 31, 2016. He lists an annual income of \$37,175. His 2015 tax return indicates he received a refund of \$7,843 that he used to pay other debts. The applicant lists assets of approximately \$3,100 including \$1,500 in a checking account that must remain in order to close on the home, household goods, a 401K account, and cash on hand. His debts include \$44,000 in student loans and several small credit card balances. The applicant requests a compromise and release of the lien with no payment or upon payment of the lowest acceptable amount. The applicant was present and addressed the Commission regarding his request. MOTION by Bender, seconded by Barth, to approve Resolution MC16-9. 4 ayes. Kelly voted nay.

The application was reviewed by the Sheriff's Office, State's Attorney's Office, and Planning & Zoning Department. There were no objections or concerns with the issuance of the license. Perry Place, Sioux Falls, SD, for a fundraising event on May 18, 2016. 5 ayes.

CONTRACT

Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, presented the 2016 annual agreement for detoxification program funding with the City of Sioux Falls. The City will pay the County \$157,500, or \$13,125 per month. The first payment the city will make will be for January through March, then continue to make equal monthly payments in the amount of \$13,125. This amount along with County and State funding will be applied to the 2016 contract with Armor to provide residential detoxification services. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Chair to sign the 2016 Agreement for Detoxification Services between the City of Sioux Falls and Minnehaha County. 5 ayes.

RIGHT OF ENTRY

Robert Wilson, Assistant Commission Administrative Officer, gave a briefing on a proposal by Buell Consulting, working on behalf of Verizon Wireless, to lease a portion of the County-owned property located at 4200 N. Westport Avenue for placement of a cell phone tower. Buell Consulting is requesting Right Of Entry authorization to survey the area, conduct soil tests, identify and mark underground utilities, and other work needed to determine if the site is suitable for placement of a cell tower. Motion by Bender, seconded by Beninga, to authorize the Chair to sign a Right Of Entry agreement granting Cellular Inc. Network Corporation d/b/a Verizon Wireless, permission to access the property at 4200 N. Westport Ave. Sioux Falls, SD, legally described as Tract 3 Hall's Addition SE ½ 31-102-49. 5 ayes.

REPORT

Bill Hoskins, Museum Director, presented the 2015 Museum Special Enterprise Fund report. The fund receives revenues and accounts for expenses associated with the rental of space in the museum system, sponsorships, and in the provision of programs, events and services for which a fee is charged. The fund is also used to further the mission of the Siouxland Heritage Museum.

OBLIGATION RECOVERY CENTER

Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, gave a briefing on the Obligations Recovery Center (ORC) whose purpose is being a central repository for identification, registration oversite, and collection of debts owed to any agency or department of the State of South Dakota. The ORC is expected to be operational by April 1, 2016. Minnehaha County has the option to use the ORC for the collection of court ordered attorney fees, or retain the current practice of attaching liens for attorney services. Should the Commission choose to not participate in using the services of the ORC at this time, they may decide to do so at a future date. Connie

Mogen, 916 S. Grandview Ave., Sioux Falls, SD, spoke against using the ORC for the collection of attorney fees. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Barth, to defer this item and re-evaluate the use of the ORC in 6 months, and authorize the State's Attorney to notify the Second Circuit Court Administration that at this time Minnehaha County will continue with the current practice of attaching liens for court ordered attorney fees. 5 ayes.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Robert Wilson, Assistant Commission Administrative Officer, gave an update and status report of the 2016 Legislative Session on bills that impact Minnehaha County.

LIAISON REPORT

Commissioner Heiberger reported on a meeting she had with 4-H. It is their intent to begin making quarterly reports to the Commission.

Commissioner Heiberger reported on sessions she attended during the Legislative NACo Conference in Washington D.C.

NEW BUSINESS

Robert Litz, Auditor, reported that absentee voting for the Sioux Falls City/School election will begin at 8:00 a.m. on March 28, 2016 in the Auditor's Office. The voter registration deadline for that election will end at 5:00 p.m. on March 28, 2016. Mr. Litz also reported that March 29, 2016 is the deadline to file primary election nominating petitions. Petitions must be turned in to the Auditor's office by 5 p.m. or postmarked by March 29, 2016, if they are being mailed to the Secretary of State's Office. Independent candidates have until April 26, 2016 to file nominating petitions with the Secretary of State or county auditor for all offices.

MOTION by Barth, seconded by Bender, to adjourn into executive session for personnel and contract negotiations. 5 ayes.
