## LIEN COMPROMISE

## RESOLUTION

Robert Litz, Auditor, presented a resolution establishing a Capital Accumulations Fund and recommended an initial designation from the General Fund to the Capital Accumulations Fund in the amount of \$1,000,000. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Barth, to approve a resolution establishing a Capital Accumulations Fund in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 and an initial transfer of \$1,000,000 from the General Fund to the Capital Accumulations Fund. Commissioner Beninga stated he would like to wait until during the budget process to determine the dollar amount to designate. Commissioner Bender agreed with Beninga. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Beninga to amend the motion by authorizing an initial designation of \$100,000 to the Capital Accumulations Fund. VOTE on amendment, 5 ayes. VOTE on main motion as amended approving Resolution MC16-17. 5 ayes.

**WHEREAS**, the Minnehaha County Commission has determined that it is in the County's best interest to establish a General Fund Assigned Fund Balance for Capital Accumulations; and

**WHEREAS**, SDCL 7-21-51 provides for the accumulation of funds for a period of longer than one year for a capital outlay purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Minnehaha County Commission has determined that the accumulated funds are to be assigned for the purchase of an Enterprise Resource Planning System; and

**WHEREAS**, the Minnehaha County Commission has determined that the initial amount to transfer is \$100,000 from the General Fund Unassigned Fund Balance to the Assigned Fund Balance for Capital Accumulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Minnehaha County Commission intends to designate additional funds as deemed necessary to accumulate an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 for the proposed Enterprise Resource Planning System, and

WHEREAS, the funds to be accumulated shall be expended within eighty-four months from the date of this resolution, now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Minnehaha County Auditor is hereby directed to transfer the appropriate amount from the General Fund Unassigned Fund Balance to the General Fund Assigned Fund Balance for Capital Accumulations.
