AGREEMENT

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, gave a briefing on a Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$41,851.00 with Infrastructure Design Group (IDG), Inc., to conduct traffic studies on various intersections throughout Minnehaha County. The purpose of the studies is to investigate existing and future operational characteristics and safety of specific intersections identified within the MPO's 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan. Phil Gunderson, Project Manager/Director with IDG, reported the study completion date will be the end of March, 2017. Traffic counts will begin in October, 2016 when harvest has begun and school is back in session. Other data collection will start earlier.
