REQUEST FOR PERSONNEL

Deferred from December 6, 2016

Aaron McGowan, State's Attorney, requested the approval to hire four new Victim Witness Assistants and one new Legal Office Assistant in order to stay compliant with Constitutional Amendment S (Marsy's Law). The number of cases in which the County will have an obligation to consult and notify victims will rise significantly. The cost for the requested positons in 2017 would be approximately \$287,000 including benefits. Kim Adamson, Finance and Budget Officer, stated the 2017 budget assumes a cash applied position of \$4.3 million and the additional staffing requests would add to that cash applied position, as there is no new funding source associated with Marsy's Law. Commissioner Barth stated Marsy's Law was passed by voters and believes they must want the County to spend the money needed to comply with the law's requirements. Joy Tuscherer, Sioux Falls, SD, spoke in support of hiring these positions for the State's Attorney's Office and cited a specific example with a victim witness assistant to show need for the positons. Mr. McGowan stated the victim witness assistants are master's level professionals who have caseloads of 300 cases. Commissioner Beninga stated he would support hiring two positions as opposed to all five positions being requested and then revisit the need for staff at a future time to see what the Legislature will do with Marsy's Law. Mr. McGowan stated he would be in support of a compromise and would come back to the Commission in the future if more staff is needed. Commissioners Kelly, Bender, and Beninga stated they would support hiring two victim witness assistants and 1 legal office assistant. MOTION by Beninga, seconded by Barth, to authorize hiring two (2) victim witness assistants and one (1) legal

office assistant for the State's Attorney's Office for 2017. 5 ayes.

APPOINTMENT

Scott Anderson, Planning Director, reported applications were received for appointment to the Minnehaha County Planning Commission from Michael J. Ralston and Bonnie Duffy. Michael J. Ralston, 400 Kelsey Circle, Crooks, SD, introduced himself to the Commission and expressed interest in serving on the Planning Commission. Bonnie Duffy, 2300 S River Bluff Rd, Sioux Falls, SD, introduced herself, spoke on her years of service on the Planning Commission, and expressed interested in being reappointed for another term. MOTION by Bender, seconded by Barth, to appoint Michael J. Ralston and reappoint Bonnie Duffy to four year terms on the Minnehaha Planning Commission beginning January 1, 2017 thru December 31, 2020. 5 ayes.

AGREEMENTS

Scott Anderson, Planning Director, gave a briefing on an agreement with Pictometry International Corp. and the City of Sioux Falls for the Pictometry Acquisition Project in the amount of \$51,643. The agreement would start on January 1, 2017, and last for three years. The cost to Minnehaha County would be \$30,818 annually over three years. The City's share of the cost is \$20,825 annually to be invoiced by the County and paid by the City in August 2017, 2018, and 2019. A memorandum of understanding with the City will be brought forward at a later date once the agreement has been approved. MOTION by Bender, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Chair to sign the Pictometry Acquisition Project agreement with Pictometry International Corp. at an annual cost to Minnehaha County of \$30,818 beginning January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019. 5 ayes.

Diane Rypkema, Director of Equalization, gave a briefing on an agreement with Pictometry International Corp. for Change Finder. Change Finder allows the County to find changes to the landscape, such as new buildings, via the comparison of a three year old aerial image to a current aerial image. The contract is in the amount of \$45,770.38 and is part of the 2017 budget. MOTION by Beninga, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Chair to sign the Change Finder agreement with Pictometry International Corp. in the amount of \$45,770.38. 5 ayes.

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, gave a briefing on an agreement with Infrastructure Design Group, Inc. (IDG) for the survey and preliminary design of two roadways located in the southeast portion of Minnehaha County. The first corridor is 7 miles long located east of Sioux Falls on Highway 146 (266th Street) between South Dakota Highway 11 and the state border. The second corridor is 3.5 miles long located on County Highway 103 (487th Avenue) between Highway 146 and the southern boundary of Valley Springs. The agreement is an hourly contract not to exceed \$178,179. MOTION by Bender, seconded by Kelly, to authorize the Chair to sign the Professional Services agreement with Infrastructure Design Group, Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$178,179. 5 ayes.

RESOLUTION

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, requested authorization for the Chair to sign the Bridge Improvement Grant Program Resolution Authorizing Submission of Applications. The South Dakota Department of Transportation is requiring a resolution be submitted to apply for the Bridge Improvement Grant. The County would be responsible for a twenty percent (20%) match. The grand funds would allow the Highway Department to complete two bridge projects: 1) bridge 50-293-200 at an estimated cost of \$53,228.06 with the County's portion being \$10,645.61 and 2) bridge 50-032-060 at an estimated cost of \$35,812.47 with the County's portion being \$7,162.50. TRAFFIC COUNT UPDATE

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, gave a briefing on the County Highway System traffic count report. The Highway Department analyzes traffic counts on half of the County Highway System each year utilizing counter tubes and/or a battery operated radar device. The seven most notable areas are 1) Park Street: Six Mile Road to Big Sioux River (1.6 miles), 2) Marion Road: 259th Street to County Highway 130 (1.0 miles), 3) Highway 17 Extensions: State Highway 42 to State Highway 38 (4.2 miles), 4) 462nd Avenue: County Highway 146 to State Highway 42 (1.0 miles), 5) County Highway 109: County Highway 114 to County Highway 104 (4.5 miles), 6) County Highway 103: County Highway 114 to State Highway 11 (6.0 miles), and 7) County Highway 104: State Highway 19 to 454th Avenue (3.0 miles). Commissioners Barth and Bender thanked the Highway Department for bringing this report forward.

GRANT

Sheriff Mike Milstead, reported Minnehaha County has been awarded an additional \$100,000 for the 2016 Homeland Security Grant. The grant will be used for a records management CAD system. This is a joint project among Minnehaha County, The City of Sioux Falls, and Metro Communications. The newly awarded amount will be split in half and used to reduce the County and City portions by \$50,000. The remaining amount will be billed based on the agreement with the City of Sioux Falls. Mr. Milstead reported the grant will be signed electronically and requests authorization to enter into the agreement. MOTION by Bender, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Minnehaha County Emergency Management Director to enter into the agreement with the South Dakota Office of Homeland Security and to authorize electronic signatures on the 2016 Homeland Security Grant Award Agreement. 5 ayes.

LEASE

Robert Wilson, Assistant Commission Administrative Officer, gave a briefing on a one year lease agreement between Minnehaha County and Metro Communications Agency. Under the terms of the agreement Metro Communications will lease 4,296 square feet of space in the Public Safety Building at \$11.40 per square foot. This is the same rate as the previous agreement. Ona Reker, Metro Communications Business Manager, stated her appreciation for the ability to continue utilizing the Public Safety Building. Commissioner Bender stated the rental rate has not changed for six years and may need to be reevaluated during next year's budget proceedings to ensure it stays at market rate. MOTION by Kelly, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Chair to sign the Lease Agreement between Minnehaha County and Metro Communications Agency for space in the Public Safety Building at \$11.40 per square foot effective January 1, 2017 thru December 31, 2017. 5 ayes.

LIAISON REPORTS

Commissioner Heiberger reported the Southeast District Meeting for the South Dakota Association of County Commissioners was held on December 7th, 2016, at the Blue Haven Barn. Ron Globke of Turner County was chosen as a new representative. The spring convention will take place March 15 and 16, 2017, in Pierre and the fall convention will be September 18 and 19, 2017, in Rapid City.

Commissioner Beninga reported on the December 8, 2016, South Eastern Council of Governments Board Meeting where the director's annual evaluation was discussed, a strategic planning session was held, and the growth of Harrisburg was discussed.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Heiberger stated the list of bad checks included with the Auditor's Account with the County Treasurer dates back to 2001 and inquired if there is something that can be done to get the older checks off the books. Kim Adamson, Finance and Budget Officer, stated the avenues to recover the funds of the older checks have been exhausted and could be written off. Commissioner Heiberger requested Ms. Adamson determine how to proceed and bring options to the Commission at a later date.

MOTION by Barth, seconded by Bender, to adjourn into executive session for contracts and personnel. 5 ayes.

The Commission adjourned until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday December 20, 2016.
