AGREEMENT

Jamie Gravett, Juvenile Detention Center Director, reported on the renewal of the Joint Powers Agreement for the counties of Minnehaha, Bon Homme, Brookings, Charles Mix, Clay, Davison, Hanson, Hutchinson, Lake, Lincoln, McCook, Miner, Moody, Turner, Union, and Yankton to provide for the temporary care, shelter, and detention of juveniles who are involved with the court system. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Karsky, to authorize the Vice Chair to sign the Joint Powers Agreement effective July 1, 2017 and ending on June 30, 2022. 4 ayes.

GRANT

Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, reported Minnehaha County has been awarded a 2017 Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$95,795.89. The grant will be used for portable radios for the Minnehaha County Sheriff's Department. The grant will be signed electronically by the Emergency Management Director. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Heiberger, to authorize the Minnehaha County Emergency Management Director to enter into the agreement with the South Dakota Office of Homeland Security and to authorize electronic signatures on the 2017 Homeland Security Grant Award Agreement. 4 ayes.

TAX DEED PROPERTIES

On the request of Bob Litz, Auditor, the following actions were taken related to the disposition of tax deed properties:

MOTION by Heiberger, seconded by Barth, to accept the findings of the Minnehaha County Tax Deed Property Appraisal Board Report. 4 ayes.

MOTION by Heiberger, seconded by Barth, to declare tax deed properties RDID 11897, RDID 76376, RDID 52766, and RDID 63906, as surplus for sale at public auction and approve the minimum bid amounts. 4 ayes. Mr. Litz noted that RDID 11897 was originally placed on the 2015 tax deed auction, but was pulled to allow DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, to mine dirt from the site and is now ready for sale.

MOTION by Karsky, seconded by Barth, to authorize the County Auditor to publish a Notice of Public Auction to be held on Saturday, September 30, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. 4 ayes.

GRANT

Jeff Gromer, Jail Warden, requested authorization for the Vice Chair to sign the Certification of Illegal Immigration Cooperation form and reported on additional consideration the U.S. Department of Justice is allowing for agencies that have applied for the FY2017 COPS Grant. The additional consideration is for agencies that cooperate with federal law enforcement to address illegal immigration. The two necessary criteria for the additional consideration are as follows: to allow U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) personnel to have access to the Minnehaha County detention facilities in order to meet with individuals concerning DHS investigation; and Minnehaha County must notify DHS as early as possible regarding the scheduled release of an alien when requested by DHS. The Certification of Illegal Immigration Cooperation form is needed to acknowledge these practices for submission. MOTION by Heiberger, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Vice Chair to sign the Certification of Illegal Immigration Cooperation form for submission to the U.S. Department of Justice for additional consideration for FY2017 COPS Grant applicants. 4 ayes.

METHOD OF SALE

Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, requested action on the method of sale for Minnehaha County owned property located at 908 West Avenue, Sioux Falls and legally described as Lots 1 to 5 & 25 & 26 Block 52 Airport Addition to City of Sioux Falls. The Commission declared the property as surplus on June 25, 2017, via Resolution MC17-18. An appraisal of the property was conducted by Shaykett Appraisal Company in July 2017. The appraised value is \$2,450,000. The property may be sold through a sealed bidding process, a real estate broker, or public auction. MOTION by Heiberger, seconded by Karsky, to sell the County owned property located at 908 West Avenue, Sioux Falls through a sealed bidding process. 4 ayes.

BUDGET

Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, provided an updated FY18 Budget Means of Finance that includes adjustments provided at the September 5, 2017, Commission Meeting. The budget stands at \$131,024,402 and includes \$46,000,000 for the jail expansion. The final budget will be adopted at the September 26, 2017, County Commission meeting.

LIAISON REPORT

Commissioner Bender reported on the September 11, 2017, Homeless Advisory Board meeting where Heather Muller, a national consultant with Coordinated Entry Systems, was present and discussed how their entry system worked in Houston, TX. Commissioner Barth reflected on past flooding at the Dakota Dunes when the river flooded.

NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Barth stated that commissioners will attend the Southeast District Meeting on September 13, 2017, where resolutions will need to be chosen to bring forward at the South Dakota Association of County Commissioners State Convention. Commissioner Heiberger stated the resolutions that are brought forward will need to be voted off the floor at the convention by two-thirds majority in order for discussion to take place.

Commissioners Barth and Karksy commented on the most recent tax incremental financing (TIF) brought forward by the City of Sioux Falls for a new development and discussed their views on the TIF process.

Commissioner Barth reflected on the September 11 anniversary and commented on a presentation he attended where former Mayor of New York City Rudy Giuliani spoke on the attacks in New York, Washington D.C., and Pennsylvania.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Heiberger stated the South Dakota Association of County Commissioners State Convention will take place in Rapid City from September 18-19, 2017, resulting in no regular County Commission meeting on September 19, 2017.

MOTION by Barth, seconded by Karsky, to adjourn into executive session for personnel. 4 ayes.

The Commission adjourned until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday September 26, 2017.
