LIAISON REPORT

Commissioner Heiberger reported on the September 18-19, 2017, South Dakota Association of County Commissioners State Convention where she attended the Secretary of State's discussion on voting and breakout

sessions regarding topics such as marijuana legalization and the restoration and collective impact initiative being done by Pennington County. Ms. Heiberger was able to speak with the National Association of Counties (NACo) First Vice-President regarding 211 services, and spoke with regional representatives regarding the benefits of NACo. It was also noted that Meade County is currently defending themselves in a lawsuit resulting from upholding South Dakota State regulations.

Commissioner Heiberger reported on the September 20, 2017, Sioux Empire Fair Board Meeting, where they discussed topics such as updating the by-laws, a revised management agreement, and plans for the 2018 Sioux Empire Fair.

Commissioner Heiberger reported on the September 25-26, 2017, Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative (JDAI) Conference. Over 80 people attended the conference, which provide an educational opportunity for counties new to JDAI, as well as continuing education for current JDAI counties at the conference.

Commissioner Heiberger reported on the September 26-27, 2017, Statewide Juvenile Summit where school climate and juvenile justice reform was discussed along with services provided by Lutheran Social Services and Department of Social Services.

Commissioner Heiberger reported on the October 3rd, 2017, Improving Criminal Justice Responses for Persons with Mental Illness HB 1183 Oversight Council meeting where discussion topics included competency filings for reimbursements, crisis response and training, and mental illness screenings for jails.

Commissioner Heiberger reported on last week's National Association of Counties phone call where the opioid epidemic was discussed. It was noted that the President plans to declare it an emergency.

NEW BUSINESS

Bob Litz, Auditor, provided an update on the 2017 sale of bonds for the jail expansion project and stated Commission action will be requested at the October 24, 2017, Commission Meeting.

MOTION by Barth, seconded by Karsky, to adjourn into executive session for personnel and litigation. 5 ayes.
