RESOLUTION MC18-9

Supporting Townships in Amending State Law To Allow Township Property Tax Levy Authority and Expenditures for Emergency Medical Services

WHEREAS, rural emergency medical response is necessary to save lives; and

WHEREAS, state statute does not currently list emergency medical services as allowed expenses within Township Levy Authority except in the circumstance of contracting;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Minnehaha County Commission that South Dakota Codified Law be amended during the 2018 Legislative Session to provide townships with the optional authority to levy property taxes for emergency medical services expenses.

Supporting Criteria

Justification for the resolution: SDCL 10-12-28.1 does not include expenses for emergency medical response services in the list of allowable expenses and levy authority except in a contract scenario. Contracting for emergency medical expenses requires for time, energy, and money for compliance. HB 1076 will offer townships a more cost effective option to support volunteer emergency medical response services. For counties and local townships that choose to support emergency responses services HB 1076 is beneficial for local governmental units to have a financial stake in service delivery.

Counties affected by the resolution: All South Dakota counties

Impact of the resolution: Townships that desire timely emergency medical response will have the optional authority to provide local support for these services through limited levy authority.
