Four bids were received from the following companies: Soukup Construction Inc., \$126,126; Blacktop Paving, \$138,430; Double H Paving Inc., \$146,875.60; and Asphalt Surfacing Co., \$147,610. Staff recommends awarding the bid to the low bidder, Soukup Construction Inc. MOTION by Karsky, seconded by Beninga, to award Bid #18-08, Juvenile Detention Center Parking Lot Replacement to Soukup Construction Inc. in the amount of \$126,126 and authorize the Chair to sign the contractor contract. 5 ayes.

### **AMENDMENT**

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, presented Amendment No. 2 to the Professional Services Agreement between Minnehaha County and Banner Associates for the design of multiple culvert replacements. The original agreement was entered into on October 16, 2017 with Amendment No. 1 to add an eleventh culvert on February 2018. Amendment No. 2 provides for the delivery of additional scope of work items and levels of effort associated with providing specific design drawings for environmental permit applications and preparing temporary and permanent easement exhibits. The amendment is an increase of \$16,000 for a total design fee of \$57,900. The completion date has been changed to June 28, 2018. MOTION by Karsky, seconded by Barth, to authorize the Chair to sign Amendment No. 2 to the Professional Services Agreement between Minnehaha County and Banner Associates, Inc. with a total design fee of \$57,900. 5 ayes.

#### **AGREEMENT**

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, presented a Professional Services Agreement between Minnehaha County and Stockwell Engineers, Inc. to conduct construction administration for Project MC16-04 County Highway 137 Reconstruction. Stockwell Engineers will provide professional inspection and oversite for the project. The cost is not to exceed \$234,012. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Karsky, to authorize the Chair to sign the Professional Services Agreement with Stockwell Engineers, Inc. to conduct construction administration for Project MC16-04 County Highway 137 Reconstruction at a cost not to exceed \$234,012. 5 ayes.

#### MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES PURCHASE

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, requested authorization to purchase various materials and supplies off of State and National procurement contracts. Tires, fuel, mastic materials, building and shop supplies, auto parts, automotive filters, digital radios, LED light bars, and steel culverts will be purchased off of procurement contracts conducted by the State of South Dakota (State), the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO), the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA), and/or Beadle County. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Bender, to authorize the Highway Department to purchase various materials and supplies through procurement contracts and to reference the attachment on the agenda item that shows the following: 1) tires off of WSCA procurement, Contract MA211, MA210, and MA208 (Utah) from Goodyear, Bridgestone/Firestone, & Michelin; 2) fuel off of a State procurement from various vendors, Contract IFB 1261 and 872; 3) mastic materials off of State procurement, Contract IFB 1239 and 17187, Item 25, from Brock White Co.; 4) building and shop supplies off of NASPO procurement, Contract 1862 (Nevada), Contract 16168, and Contract 16096 from Fastenal and Grainger; 5) auto parts off of NASPO procurement, Contract 09000006747 (Oklahoma), Contract 17017, and Contract 17018 from NAPA and O'Reilly Automotive; 6) automotive filters off of State procurement, Contract IFB 793 and 17011 from IState Trucks; 7) digital radios off of State procurement, Contract 18731 from Motorola through Sioux Falls Two Way Radio Service, Inc.; 8) LED light bars off of NASPO procurement, Contract 81295 (Minnesota), Contract 16951, Contract 81297 (Minnesota), and Contract 16952 from SoundOff Signal and Whelen Engineering Co.; and 9) steel culverts off of Beadle County procurement, annual contract, from True North Steel. 5 ayes.

#### **PRESENTATIONS**

Julie Hofer, Public Advocate Director, gave a presentation of the Public Advocate Department including the history, current staffing, growth, purpose, expenditures, and the number of cases closed in 2017.

Amy Carter, Children's Inn Operations Director, gave a presentation on the Children's Inn highlighting the following areas: emergency shelter services, 2017 shelter statistics, client departures, crisis intervention, additional services provided, client demographics, funding sources, challenges, and successes. Dave Nelson, Children's Inn Board Member, spoke on the history and need for the organization.

Lynn Keller Forbes, South Eastern Council of Governments Executive Director, gave a presentation on the South Eastern Council of Governments (SECOG) highlighting the following areas: the structure of SECOG, 2017 revenues, project development and funding applications, 2017 funding and return on investment, land use regulation tools, coordination of the Metropolitan Planning Organization, the South Eastern Development Foundation, and South Dakota Business Finance.

Cindy Dannenbring, Executive Director of Inter-Lakes Community Action Partnerships, gave a presentation on the services the organization provides in Minnehaha County such as volunteer income tax assistance, weatherization assistance, public transit, and the Early Head Start program. Tammie Denning, Director of Heartland House, provided a brief explanation of the Heartland House program.

Gay Tuschen, Carroll Institute Executive Director, gave a presentation on the services they provide including promotion/early intervention, outpatient/CBISA treatment, intensive outpatient treatment, clinically managed low intensity residential treatment, and prevention.

## **POLICY**

Craig Dewey, Assistant Commission Administrative Officer, presented a proposed addition to the Minnehaha County Policy and Procedures Manual, Section IX Public Use of County Facilities and Grounds, A. Petition Gatherers. House Bill (HB) 1004, HB 1177, and HB 1196 prompted Commission staff to review and propose an addition to the current policy. The following statements would be added to the end of the current policy: "Petition signature gathers are responsible for ensuring signature gathering efforts abide by all applicable laws regarding

petition signature collection enacted by the State of South Dakota. Failure to follow the described petition gatherers policy will result in the petitioner being asked to leave County property. Failure to abide by all laws or leave County property upon request may result in removal or arrest by law enforcement officials." Commissioners expressed interest in removing the first sentence of the proposed addition due to it being unnecessary. Carol Muller, Commission Administrative Officer, and Bob Litz, Auditor, commented on reasons for keeping the first sentence. MOTION by Bender, seconded by Barth, to approve the proposed addition to the Minnehaha County Policy and Procedures Manual, Section IX Public Use of County Facilities and Grounds, A. Petition Gatherers with the removal of the first sentence of the proposed addition. 5 ayes.

MOTION by Karsky, seconded by Beninga, to adjourn into executive session pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2(1) and (3). 5 ayes.
