Court Appointed Attorney and Public Defender services were provided to the applicant's minor child between September 2014 and March 2015. The lien is in the name of the applicant and his ex-spouse. They were divorced in April 2008 and have joint custody of their children. The applicant is considering refinancing his home at the end of April 2019 and has requested the lien be compromised in full only as it applies to his portion of the lien upon payment of \$480.55. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Karsky, to approve Resolution MC19-13. By roll call vote: 4 ayes.

RESOLUTION MC19-13

WHEREAS, a County Aid Lien in the amount of \$961.10, purports to exist in favor of Minnehaha County and against DPNO 86030 as Lienee, and

WHEREAS, said lienee has filed an application with the County Auditor stating such facts as provided for by Law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that after due consideration of the circumstances the Board of County Commissioners finds it advisable and proper to authorize the Chair of the County Board and the County Auditor to execute the following:

BRIEFING

Jason Gearman, Sheriff's Office Director of Emergency Management, gave a briefing on the flooding issues affecting Minnehaha County and the upcoming snow/rain forecasted for the later part of the week.

PRESENTATION

Traci Smith, Public Defender, and Mike Miller, Chief Deputy Public Defender, gave a presentation on the Public Defender Department highlighting the following areas: recent projects, community education, alternative sentencing, current projects, and future projects.

AGREEMENT

Drew DeGroot, Senior Deputy State's Attorney, presented a three (3) year agreement between Minnehaha County and Thomson Reuters for the Westlaw legal research software package. The package has a monthly

rate of \$1,646.92 with a 3% increase for years two and three of the agreement. This is \$9.71 more per month than the current agreement. The additional cost provides access to briefs filed in all federal and all 50 state courts. Access to these briefs would reduce the amount of time spent by attorneys on conducting legal research. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Karsky, to authorize the Chair to sign the three year agreement between Minnehaha County and Thomson Reuters for the Westlaw legal research software package at a total cost of \$61,085.64. 4 ayes.

SURPLUS

Joe Bosman, Deputy Sheriff Captain, requested a 2018 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor be declared surplus. On March 9, 2019, the vehicle was involved in a collision with another vehicle resulting in disabling damage. The other party has been found liable by their insurance company, Progressive Insurance. Progressive Insurance has offered a payout amount of \$26,483.25 to declare the interceptor a total loss and take the title. The vehicle was not scheduled to be replaced this year, but will be included in the request for vehicles at a later meeting after the City of Sioux Falls has conducted their 2019 bid. MOTION by Beninga, seconded by Barth, to declare a 2018 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor, VIN 1FM5K8ARXJGC19385, Asset #10025, as surplus to release to Progressive Insurance. By roll call vote: 4 ayes.

BID AWARDS

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, reported on the March 27, 2019, bid opening for Bid #19-8, Project MC16-02, replacement of Structures 50-072-100 and 50-070-098. Two bids were received from the following companies: Graves Construction Company at \$1,775,225.18; and SFC Civil Constructors at 2,054,446.10. The engineer's estimate by Infrastructure Design Group Inc was \$1,427,681.70. Staff recommended rejecting all bids and to re-bid at the beginning of May with less restrictive time provisions to encourage more competitive bids. MOTION by Karsky, seconded by Barth, to reject all bids from the March 27, 2019, bid opening for Bid #19-8, Project MC16-02, replacement of Structures 50-072-100 and 50-070-098. By roll call vote: 4 ayes.

RESOLUTION

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, presented a resolution for participation in the SD Department of Transportation (SDDOT) Bridge Inspection/Re-Inspection Program. The U.S. Federal Highway Administration requires inspection of all bridges every two years and culverts every four years. MOTION by Karsky, seconded by Beninga, to authorize the Chair to sign Resolution MC19-14. By roll call vote: 4 ayes.

RESOLUTION MC19-14 BRIDGE REINSPECTION PROGRAM RESOLUTION FOR USE WITH SDDOT RETAINER CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, Title 23, Section 151, *United States Code* and Title 23, Part 650, Subpart C, *Code of Federal Regulations*, requires initial inspection of all bridges and reinspection at intervals not to exceed two years with the exception of reinforced concrete box culverts that meet specific criteria. These culverts are reinspected at intervals not to exceed four years.

<u>THEREFORE</u>, <u>Minnehaha</u> County is desirous of participating in the Bridge Inspection Program using Bridge Replacement funds.

The County requests SDDOT to hire <u>Civil Design</u>, <u>Inc.</u> (Consulting Engineer) for the inspection work. SDDOT will secure federal approvals, make payments to the Consulting Engineer for inspection services rendered, and bill the County for 20% of the cost. The County will be responsible for the required 20% matching funds.
