ABATEMENTS

Chris Lilla, Director of Equalization, recommended denial of ten (10) abatement applications for the 100% permanent and total veteran exemption under SDCL 10-4-40. A veteran must have been rated 100% permanent and total disabled by the Veteran Affairs Office and have owned their home by November 1, 2017, in order to qualify for an abatement of 2018 taxes payable in 2019. Because the applicants did not purchase their property until after November 1, 2017, the abatements are being recommended for denial. However, the applicants will be given the exemption for 2019 taxes payable in 2020. MOTION by Barth to approve the abatements. Motion died for lack of a second. MOTION by Heiberger, seconded by Karsky, to deny abatements representing the veteran tax exemption for 2018 property taxes payable in 2019 for the following properties: Parcel ID 18341, Parcel ID 23994, Parcel ID 26279, Parcel ID 39409, Parcel ID 70846, Parcel ID 75906, Parcel ID 76496, Parcel ID 78717, Parcel ID 87486, and Parcel ID 87914. By roll call vote: 4 ayes. Barth voted nay.

TAX DEED

Bob Litz, Auditor, requested that RDID 65784 be declared surplus for sale at public auction, have the minimum bid amount approved, and authorize the publication of the Notice of Sale. RDID 65784 was recommended by the Minnehaha County Surplus Property Appraisal Board for sale at public auction. The minimum bid amount was recommended to be \$10,518.67 based on the amount of taxes, specials, and interest owed on the property.

The board appraised the property to have a value of \$142,000.00. In response to a question from Commissioner Karsky regarding federal lien against RDID 65784, Maggie Gillespie, Senior Deputy State's Attorney, spoke on the responsibility of the purchaser to satisfy any liens against the property and to account for liens in their decision to buy. MOTION by Heiberger, seconded by Karsky, to declare RDID 65784 as surplus for sale at public auction and approve the minimum bid amount for the property. By roll call vote: 5 ayes. MOTION by Beninga, seconded by Heiberger, to authorize the Auditor to publish a Notice of Sale for public auction on October 26, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. 5 ayes.

Bob Litz, Auditor, presented a resolution for the transfer of RDID 63567 to the adjacent property owner. On October 1, 2019, RDID 63567 was declared surplus for the purpose of transfer. The Minnehaha County Surplus Appraisal Board recommended that the property be transferred to the adjacent property owner, who has agreed to the transfer. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Beninga, to approve Resolution MC19-48 to transfer RDID 63567 to the adjacent property owner. By roll call vote: 5 ayes.

DJ Buthe, Highway Superintendent, presented the Minnehaha County 5 Year (2020-2024) Transportation and Bridge Improvement Plan. Over one hundred fifty (150) invitations were sent to the townships, communities, fire departments, school boards, etc. One person attended the public hearing. Structure 50-206-200 was added to the

five year plan due to the bridge inspection finding the structure deficient and needing to be posted at 75% of standard legal loads. The following structures will be scheduled for replacement within the five year plan if the funds are awarded: 50-272-030, 50-208-130, and 50-290-131. MOTION by Barth, seconded by Karsky, to adopt the Minnehaha County 5 Year (2020-2024) Transportation and Bridge Improvement Plan. 5 ayes.

Commissioner Heiberger reported on attending a Safety & Justice Challenge Conference last week as part of the MacArthur Grant application process. The primary focus of the conference was to put together a five (5) year communication plan. Commissioner Heiberger attended a breakout session regarding Native American relations and attended a jail review workshop.

Commissioner Bender reported that the contract with Lincoln County to house their inmates in the Minnehaha County Jail became effective on October 1, 2019, which helps to fund operational costs.
