Erin Srstka, University of South Dakota Community Projects Director, presented on Minnehaha County Pretrial Services including the history of pretrial services, public safety assessment data, pretrial monitoring expansion, case processing, policies and procedures, and the impact of COVID-19. Amanda Petersen, Pretrial Coordinator, spoke on the utilization of facial recognition technology for the monitoring program. Holly Hansen, Pretrial Coordinator, gave a demonstration of the facial recognition technology through the SCRAM TouchPoint mobile monitoring application. Janel Ingalls, Pretrial Coordinator Team Lead, spoke on the process for individuals who fail to check-in. Michelle Boyd, Programs and Services Manager, introduced Jasmine Thelen, Deputy Sheriff Corporal, who assists with Pretrial, the 24/7 Program, and Electronic Monitoring. Ms. Boyd spoke on Pretrial Services being the beginning of the process from the time someone is arrested until their court appearance.
