BRIEFING

Scott Buss, Minnehaha Community Water Corp Executive Director, gave a presentation on the Minnehaha Community Water Corporation. The Minnehaha Community Water Corporation had record number of gallons used on June 8, 2021 with 6,817,000 gallons. Mr. Buss stated that they currently have issue with the supply and demand of the water. The presentation also highlighted the future projects that the Minnehaha Community Water Corporation is looking at pursuing including the construction of two towers and the partnership with Big Sioux Community Water, which will be the construction of the new treatment facility. Finally, Mr. Buss stated that the Minnehaha Community Water in the area.

Cindy Dannenbring and Tammie Denning with Inter-Lakes Community Action Partnership, gave a presentation on the activities that have been completed over the past twelve months. Some of the highlights included that the Headstart program is full and has a waiting list, heating assistance funding, volunteers helping with the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program, assistance given to those in need of affordable housing, and other housing issues. Inter-Lakes Community Action Partnership also provided aide to households related to the COVID-19 pandemic including rent or mortgage and utility assistance, as well as mobile phone payment assistance and food or food vouchers.
